Location: Hinsdale Central High School, 5500 S. Grant Street, Hinsdale, IL 60521

<u>Facility</u>: 10 lane, 25-yard competition pool; five additional lanes available at all times for warm-up/cooldown. It is equipped with non-turbulent lane lines, temporary starting blocks, a horn start system with a strobe and automatic timing with touch pads. Starting depth end of the pool is 12'6" and depth at the turn end is 7'0". The facility is owned and operated by the Hinsdale Township High School District 86. As necessary, staff at the facility will handle operational matters. Please note that the Host Club does not control operational decisions. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

Entry/Exit: All swimmers, coaches, officials and volunteers should enter and exit as shown on the map in Addendum B. Swimmers can be dropped off at the indicated drop off/pick up point or they can walk through the school building using Door 14.

Rules & Safety: This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Illinois Swimming, Inc. All USA Swimming and ISI rules apply including safety rules, which will be strictly enforced. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

<u>Coaches</u>: All coaches must be currently registered with USA Swimming and must provide proof of current registration at all sessions of this meet. Coaches must continuously display their current USA Swimming coaching membership cards or the HSC-provided lanyard at all times while on deck. All coaches are required to sign in if they are on deck or if they are off deck and engaging with swimmers.

<u>Conduct</u>: All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club has proper supervision at all times. Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking or vaping on the premises. Please encourage your swimmers to clean up after themselves.

<u>Recording Devices and Swimmer Privacy</u>: In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 – the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in the changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms. Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

<u>Drones:</u> Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

<u>Image Authorization</u>: All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of Illinois Swimming and the meet host under the conditions authored by Illinois and USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in this Illinois Swimming competition to promote such competitions.

<u>MAAPP</u>: All applicable adults participating or associated with the respective meet to which this information applies, acknowledges that they are an applicable adult, subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. All athletes 18 years of age and older must have completed Athlete Protection Training prior to the entry deadline.

Eligibility: Only USA Swimming and FINA registered swimmers are eligible. Entries listed "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. All swimmers must be registered prior to the entry deadline. USA registration forms can be obtained from Illinois Swimming, Inc.; 1400 East Touhy Ave. Suite 410, Des Plaines, IL 60018 (847) 824-1596, FAX (847) 824-1726 or ilswim.org. In all events swimmers must swim in their own age group. Age for this meet shall be the swimmer's age as of November 19th, 2021.

Parking: Parking is available in the parking lots as indicated on Addendum B.

Spectators: As of the writing of this meet document spectators will be permitted and masks must be worn at all times. The meet will also be live streamed and links will be provided. We reserve the right to prohibit spectators if the facility makes that request and/or if the Illinois Department of Public Health COVID protocols necessitate the change.

Admissions: No admission fees will be charged.

<u>Heat Sheets</u>: The meet, including heat sheets, will be available online <u>at no charge</u> through the Meet Mobile app and Live Results. Heat sheets will be posted for swimmers at several places on deck and available to coaches at the Admin table. We will have a limited number of printed heat sheets available for purchase by spectators for each session.

<u>Concessions</u>: Concessions will be available. Hospitality and meals will be provided for coaches and officials while working the meet.

Warm-ups: Teams will receive warmup assignments the week preceding the meet.

Results: Results will be available at www.thehinsdaleswimclub.com at the conclusion of the meet and will be made available utilizing the Meet Mobile app.

Scoring/Awards: Awards will be given for the top ten individual finishers of each individual event in 12 and under events. There will be no individual event awards for 13 and overs. There will be no team trophies awarded. Coaches are to pick up awards at the end of the meet prior to receiving their final results.

<u>Timers</u>: There will be one timer per lane, parents of swimmers in each session may be requested to volunteer.

<u>Distance Events/Positive Check-In</u>: There will only be positive check-in for all events in Session 1 and the 500 Free in Session 4. All other events will be pre-seeded prior to the start of each session. Deck entries will not be permitted. Swimmers must provide their own counter and timer for the 500 Freestyle and 1000 Freestyle in Session 1 as well as the 500 Freestyle in Session 4.

Positive check-in deadlines are as follows:

All events in Session 1: 4pm on Friday, November 19 500 Free in Session 4: 3pm on Saturday, November 20

Entries: All events are timed finals and swimmers are limited to swim 3 individual events per session. There will be no refunds for scratched events, declared false starts, no shows or canceled events. No swimmers may be added to the meet once the file has been submitted to Illinois Swimming.

Entry Fees: Individual events are \$5.00 each. In addition, the host club will collect a surcharge of \$2.00 per swimmer (for ISI) and a facility charge of \$23.00 per swimmer. Please make checks payable to HINSDALE SWIM CLUB. If the Host Team cancels event/heats to meet timeline requirements, the related event fee(s) will be refunded.

Relays: There will be no relays.

Starts: Flyover starts will be used.

<u>Seeding</u>: All events will be pre-seeded with the exception of the distance events as defined above which require positive check in. Each event will be swum in heats with swimmers seeded from slowest to fastest, except for the 500 Freestyle and 1000 Freestyle in Session 1 and the 500 Freestyle in Session 4. These events will be swum fastest to slowest, alternating women's and men's heats.

Entry Limit: We reserve the right to limit heats for all events in order to adhere to the meet's required timelines.

Entry Deadline: Entries will not be accepted after 9:00 am, Friday, October 29th, 2021. Entry submitter will be notified via e-mail within 48 hours of admission to the meet. Entries shall not be considered finalized until entry form and payment is delivered to entry chairperson which as stated above shall be within 72 hours of notification of acceptance. Updated seed times will be accepted until 12:00pm (noon), Wednesday, November 10th, 2021. Admissions/deletions may be accepted at the discretion of the Entry Chair also through November 10th, 2021. Deck entries will not be accepted.

E-mail Entries & Forms: Only e-mail entries will be accepted and the following guidelines must be followed:

- 1.) Official entry form, all entry fees and swimmer surcharges are due within 72 hours following entry acceptance.
- 2.) E-mail entries must be in the form of a Hy-Tek Meet Manager generated format. You must "zip" the file so that it arrives to the entry chair intact to the following e-mail: suegould39@gmail.com. Hinsdale Swim Club will use Hy-Tek Meet Manager 8.0 software to run the meet.
- 3.) Your club's entire entry must be sent in one e-mail. Please do not send multiple e-mails which compose one single team entry. The host club accepts no responsibility for receipt or quality of the transmission.
- 4.) The file will be set up to accept entries in the format of YLS and will be seeded in that order.
- 5.) The enclosed Summary of Fees Statement must be completed and the Release Form signed. These must be returned together with the entry forms and your check to the Meet Entry Chair. Failure to do so shall be sufficient grounds for refusal of the entry.

2021 HSC Fall Classic November 19-21, 2021 Warm-Up Procedures (To Be Posted)

A. WARM-UP PROCEDURES

1. General Warm-up

- a. There will be assigned warm-up lanes for this meet.
- b. Entry into pool from starting end of pool only, unless noted otherwise by the Meet Director and Meet Referee.
- c. No diving shall be allowed from the blocks or the edge of the pool at any time when a lane is being used for any one swimmers to swim more than one length. At such times, swimmers must enter the pool feet first, while maintaining contact with the deck with the body and a hand from the start end of the pool.
- d. When a coach converts the use of a lane to a diving lane, swimmers shall swim one length from the start end and exit the pool at the turn end. No swimmer shall return to the start end or linger in swimming to the turn end to exit the pool.

B. SAFETY GUIDELINES

1. Coaches Responsibilities

- a. Coaches shall instruct their swimmers regarding safety guidelines and warm-up procedures as they apply to conduct at meets and practices.
- b. Coaches shall actively supervise their swimmers throughout the Warm-up session at meets and all practices.

2. Host Team Responsibilities

- a. Marshaling
 - 1) A minimum of two (2) marshals, who report to and receive instructions from the Meet Referee, shall be on the deck during the warm-up session.
 - 2) Marshals shall have the authority to remove from the deck, for the remainder of the warm-up session, any swimmer or coach who is in violation of safety or warm-up procedures.
- b. The host team shall provide signs for each lane at both ends of the pool, which indicate the designated use during warm-up.
- c. Warm-up times and lane assignments shall be published in the meet information and posted at several locations around the pool area. The following statement shall appear in the information: "Illinois Swimming, Inc. Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in affect at this meet."
- d. An announcer shall be on duty each Warm-up session to announce lane and/or time changes and to assist with the conduct of the Warm-up. Coaches are encouraged to plan for Warm-ups in advance.
- e. Hazards in locker rooms, on the deck area or in areas used by coaches, swimmers, spectators, or officials shall be removed or clearly marked.

3. Miscellaneous:

- a. Backstrokers shall ensure that they are not starting at the same time as a swimmer on the blocks.
- b. Swimmers shall not jump or dive into the pool to stop another swimmer on a recalled start.
- c. Swimmers are required to exit the pool upon completion of their warm-up to allow other swimmers adequate warm-up time. The pool is not for visiting or playing during the warm-up session.
- d. Warm-up procedures shall be enforced for any breaks scheduled during the competition.
- e. The Referee may restrict use of bands, hand paddles, or fins during warm-up. The Referee shall have control over mitigation actions necessary to relieve situations deemed as dangerous or impairing the safety of other swimmers.

Note: The host club may, the consent of the Meet Director and Meet Referee, modify the warm-up time schedule or recommend lane assignments depending on pool configuration, number of swimmers or other consideration, so long as safety considerations are not compromised. Any such changes shall be announced, and/or posted prominently in the pool area.

Addendum A COVID Policies and Procedures HSC Fall Classic – November 19-21, 2021

Illinois Department of Health Protocols and Requirements

- There currently no limitations on events
- Masks will be worn by all attendees at all times, other than by swimmers when they are competing

- Athletes will enter and exit the facility as indicated on Addendum B
- Locker rooms are open for use, and will be monitored to make sure there is not an excessive number of swimmers at any one time

Number of Individuals in Each Area of the Facility


- There are currently no limitations on the number of persons permitted in individual areas of the pool facility
